In common with much of the sector, Yes to Life has experienced a challenging year amidst the increasingly harsh climate for charities. Nonetheless, support for our mission has continued to grow alongside an increasing recognition of the importance of a broader approach to cancer care, as advocated by Yes to Life for over 15 years. Over the same period, the need for Yes to Life's services has risen markedly as a direct result of the pandemic. By responding creatively, the charity has been able to deliver to more people in a raft of innovative ways, on a lower budget.

In parallel, connections with the NHS have continued to grow, and the first

shoots of constructive dialogue with mainstream cancer care regarding integration have appeared, alongside public support from senior NHS oncology professionals. WIGWAM

Wigwam is an online cancer support group initiative with a difference. It is a community of people living with cancer coming together to explore and share information and experiences, with the aim of empowering themselves to gain control over their lives. Wigwam is a place for people to meet locally or online. Wigwam is a place of safety and care which is flexible and supportive in which to meet others sharing similar issues, and to learn about Integrative Medicine.

21 Forums delivered with over472 attendees

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Income for the year amounted to £159K, a decreased of £15K from 2019, of which £74K was unrestricted and £85K restricted. Expenditure amounted to £185K, a significant decreased from the £372K in 2019.
